



YOUR WINDOW ART

Step One: Set Up Your Work Area

Find a flat surface that you can use as your work area. Picnic table or kitchen table works well. Cover your work area with plastic tablecloth, scrap paper, newspaper or paper towel. Keep the box nearby or the story book so that you can look at the pictures to get ideas. Now you are ready to begin creating your beautiful window art!

Step Two: Start Creating! Creating Sun Catchers:

- 1. Decide which sun catcher you are going to paint first and plan out the colors that you are going to use. Lay the sun catcher flat on your work area with the side with the raised lines facing up. Gently squeeze the window paint onto the sun catcher. Once you have finished painting your sun catcher, let the paint dry overnight.
- 2. Once the paint has dried completely, you can attach the suction cup hanger to your sun catcher. First cut the string into 12 OR 24 equal pieces so that you will have one for each sun catcher. Insert the end of the string into the hole on the top of your sun catcher. Tie the ends of the string together forming a big loop. Dampen the suction cup and firmly stick it to a clean spot on the window. Then hang the loop that you just created with the string onto the hook.

Creating Peel and Stick Window Art:

- 1. Use the emoji paper (bundled with PR-12 package only) or the coloring pages (bundled with Sun-24 only) and take your acetate sheet and place it over the image you would like to create. Tape the acetate to the coloring page so that it doesn't move out of place.
- 2. Using the black paint, trace the outline of your chosen design. Let the black paint dry completely.
- 3. Fill in each area of your design with your desired color by squeezing the paint tube lightly. Once you have completed your design, let the paint dry overnight.
- 4. To remove your window art creation from the acetate sheet, carefully peel it off. Now it's ready to be put on display in your window. Simply find a clean spot on the window pane and stick your creation to it. Remember you can remove and re-use your window art creations by simply peeling them off of the window and then placing them in a different spot.

Note: If you want to create a large design in the coloring book, you will need to replenish the paint supply, as our 8 or 12 beautiful paint tubes are designed for the 12 or 24 sun catchers packages.

Or you can simply draw your designs directly onto the acetate sheet with black paint and let dry completely. Then follow steps 3 and 4 above.
